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

 Deep alluvial soils on the cool east side of the Russian River. Open top fermentation. Aged for 15 months in French oak (30% new).

 100% Zinfandel. Picked: October 2-5, 2004.

 Aroma: Rich black cherry, lush wild berry and hints of caramel. Taste: Bursts of cherry followed by a touch of nutmeg and a sweet, candied finish.
