Sand and chalk soils in the Monforte d'Alba region of Barolo. Temperature controlled fermentation. Aged for 30 months in French oak barrels (100% new) and bottle aged for 12 months before release.

GRAPES

100% Nebbiolo. Picked: October 10, 2001.

TASTING NOTES

Aroma: Rich, complex and earthy with a broad bouquet.

Taste: Deep plum and dark fruit flavors with hints of chestnut, mushroom and white truffles.
